Living in the bush makes resolving this kind of problem far more difficult than if we lived in a large city. It took over a month but we got the problem resolved. Shortly after that both Louise' and my briefcases were stolen with our laptops, passwords and several other important items. Again, living in the bush makes resolving these problems much more complicated. But, Praise God, here we are today overcoming the obstacles and once again sending you this report!

BIG Praise: in March our Disciple Making Movement groups grew to 476 groups with 107 new groups. We had 4,403 people attending a group meeting each week. We are rejoicing that 1,079 people responded to the Good News and surrendered their lives to Christ. 410 of those people were water baptized and 241 were filled with the Holy Spirit. Thank you Jesus!

Praise: We have been able to increase our DMM staff by several people, and equip them.

Praise: Many healings! A paralyzed person was healed also several with back pain, digestive problems, a scorpion bite, epilepsy, pneumonia, malaria, typhoid, eye issues, menstrual bleeding and deliverances from demonization.

Praise: We have been able to equip our new disciple makers with transportation, phones, raingear and other things that helps make them more effective.

Praise: Our DMM is spreading. We now have new groups in western Uganda, in Luwero, in the camps near Aura among the Congolese and Nuba Mountain people.

Praise: We are sponsoring a Work For Life training in Tororo, 29 people are signed up for it.

Prayer: Our DMM is in the multiplying stage which is exciting, but it means we have to change to manage the growth. We are increasing the number of people in supervisory roles. Please pray for these people and that God will give wisdom to continue leading. We need wisdom and strength do the job.

Prayer: Louise and I don't have plans to retire any time soon but, we want to have a good plan for this inevitable change, pray for this.

Prayer: The ministry is going great with many salvations, miracles, healings and deliverances but it feels like we have been barraged with many little annoyances like being buzzed by flies. Computer problems, sickness, many car repairs, the young man wrecking our vehicle, a landlord who is hassling us in spite of our improvements to the property, dealing with corruption etc... And no, I have not been praying for patience. Please pray that this will end.

Prayer: Please prayer for good health, strength and wisdom for us.

Prayer: We need a financial surge to do the things God is opening up to us. Pray for our finances to increase.

Prayer: Lokiden Evans is a vital part of our ministry who has been with us for about 14 years. As a boy soldier he missed out on his education. We have sent him to Kampala for 3 months to receive one-on-one English tutoring from a young American teacher, living in Uganda. Pray that Lokiden will get it!
